You will need:

- ♦ Template
- ♦ Cardboard
- ♦ Scissors
- ♦ Coloured pens or pencils
- 2 Starting with the roof, fold down along the dotted line on each side (this will create the cabin).

- Many barges travel up and down the Bridgewater Canal, have a go at making your own!
- Using the template on the next page, draw around the shape onto a piece of sturdy card (you can use a cereal box or something similar).
- 3 Fold the front and back flap up (this will be the deck).




- 4. Using scissors make 2 cuts at each end of the boat along the dotted lines (leaving a section uncut).
- Turn the barge around and make 2 more cuts in the opposite direction (leaving a section uncut).





- 6. Slot the front and the back of the barge together and you now have your own Bridgewater Barge!
- 7 Now you're ready to decorate your barge. Perhaps you could go for a walk along the Bridgewater Canal to get some inspiration? Someone waving, a sleeping cat or a flower pot? And don't forget to give your barge a name!
